

Vino Spumante – Sparkling Wine

Prosecco di Valdobbiadene “Brut” NV

Santa Margherita, Veneto

Made from 100% Prosecco di Valdobbiadene grapes, this has a straw color and small bubbles. A touch of pear and melon in the aroma, this is crisp and clean with nice acidity and has a refreshing dry finish.

Zarina Gellewza Frizzante Rose

Delicata, Malta

A fruity semi sparkling medium dry rose wine made from the Maltese indigenous grape Gellewza. Its consistent stem of fizz pushes up a most wonderful bouquet and flavours.

Vino Bianco – White Wine

Pinot Grigio del Trentino, 2005

Bottega Vinai, Trentino Alto Adige

Pale yellow / green colour, and a slightly floral, peachy fruited nose with a faint echo of straw and honey. The mouth feel is smooth and rich, with a stylish, limpid, pear fruit quality. Very food friendly.

Soave Tuffaie, 2004

Bolla, Veneto

Straw yellow color, almost green, delicate and light, with a hint of almonds. Think perfumes and gentle flowers. Gentle acidity. A slightly bitter finish.

Gavi del Comune di Gavi ‘Silver Label’ 2005

La Scolca, Piemonte

Vinified from grapes of exuberant vineyards located in the heart of Rovereto of Gavi, a place worldwide known as the ‘Gran Cru of Gavi’. Light straw in colour, fine and pleasantly fresh, delicate, very dry, characterised by fairly marked acidulous notes.

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, 2005

Umani Ronchi, Marche

Produced from Verdicchio grapes from the Castelli di Jesi Classico appellation area inland from the port of Ancona which is bathed by cooling sea breezes from the Adriatic Sea. Attractive floral, ripe apple, honey and almond characters on the nose are perfectly mirrored on the concentrated palate with its effortlessly elegant finish.

Orvieto Classico

Ghiberti, Umbria

The wine has a straw yellow colour. Its bouquet is elegant and fresh, with scents of hawthorn flowers and hints of musk and almonds. On the palate, the wine is dry, full and soft, with attractive notes of white peaches and bitter almonds.

Trebbiano di Romagna

Crete di Lamone, Lazio

Pale yellow colour, fruity flavour, dry and sapid taste. Accompanies well sea food and octopus salad and pasta dishes with fish based sauces.

Frascati Superiore

‘Vigna Santa Teresa’, 2005

Fontana Candida, Lazio

Pale gold colour, delicate but well-defined bouquet, with fine hints of sage and apple, full, soft but fresh and a lively and very savoury flavour with a definite, pleasantly lingering aftertaste of sweet almonds. A wine of great finesse.

Corvo Glicine

Vini Corvo, Sicilia

A dry fresh wine made from native grapes. Fruity aromas lead to full flavour on the palate and a hint of almonds.

‘Scurati’ Grecanico, 2005

Azienda Agricola Ceuso, Sicilia

The region of Alcamo in Sicily is known for its white wines. The white ‘Scurati’ made from pure Grecanico is a fresh light wine, with somewhat low acidity and subtle fruit that tends to balance rather than overpower the palate

Anthilia

Donnafugata, Sicilia

The wine shows a precise personality linked with extremely sweet and elegant fruity sensations and notes of yellow peaches and plums. On the palate, sapidity and softness unite.

Cusumano Alcamo, 2006

Sicilia

The Alcamo is a blend of four grapes that are difficult to pronounce but deceptively easy to drink. Fresh floral characteristics blend with ripe tropical fruit on the nose and palate.

Vino Bianco di Malta – Maltese White Wine

La Valette Vin Blanc

Marsovin

An elegant and light wine with fresh tropical fruit aromas, suggestive of the Sauvignon Blanc grapes in the blend. In taste, it is pleasantly smooth, with a balanced acidity and substantially long finish associated with wines made from noble Chardonnay, the dominant variety in this wine..

Medina Vineyards , Chardonnay/Ghigentina, 2006

Delicata

A skilful blend of the Malta grown noble grape, Chardonnay and the indigenous white grape Grigentina. The crispness and freshness of the Ghigentina compliments the fruitiness and complexity of the Chardonnay perfectly to produce a refreshing dry white wine.

‘Isis’ Chardonnay, 2006

Meridiana

Meridiana’s grapes are all sustainably farmed and gently vinified to produce elegant, dry, fruit-driven and characteristically Maltese white and red wines. Isis is exclusively made from Chardonnay grapes, Isis is characterised by fresh, natural, tropical fruit flavours.

Vino Dolce – Sweet Wine

Moscato D’Asti ‘Nivole’, 2006

Michele Chiarlo, Piemonte

Fragrant, intensely fruity bouquet, offset by musky notes, leads to a refined sweetness supported by an excellent acid balance on the palate, with a suggestion of effervescence in the texture. Clean and crisp finish.

Casella Moscato

Delicata

A deliciously golden sweet rich concentrated wine that is the perfect accompaniment to most desserts. This wine is produced entirely from Moscato grapes and has a wonderful marmaladely flavour with scents of honey and butterscorth.

Vino Rosato – Rose Wine

Medina Vineyards Rose Grenache

Delicata, Malta

This fine Rosé has an intense aroma reminiscent of fresh apple and warm spice, it is medium bodied and is best served lightly chilled accompanying veal, pork and poultry dishes.

Corvo Rosa

Vini Corvo, Sicilia

A bright rosé colour with cherry red highlights. The aromas are rich, fragrant and finely fruity with the scent of wild berries. The flavour is balanced, well bodied, lively and with a good persistence.

Cusumano Rosato 2006

Sicilia

A beautiful dry style rose made from one of Sicily's main red grapes, Nerello Mascalese. It is light-to-medium pink in color and displays strawberry, cherry and other lighter red fruit on the nose and palate.

Vino Rosso – Red Wine

Valpolicella Classico

Bolla, Veneto

Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara make this fruit driven wine full of flavours reminiscent of wild cherries.

Bardolino

Carlevari, Veneto

The wine is pale ruby red. Its elegant bouquet is vinous and delicate. On the palate, the wine is dry, flavourful and well-balanced, with an attractive, slightly bitter finish.

'Ruvei' Barbera D'Alba 2004

Marchesi Di Barolo, Piemonte

A wine that offers fantastic value for money. Based on the Barbera grape, the second most important of the Piedmont region. The wine offers a range of fruit flavours, a nice structure and a refreshing acidity that makes it very food friendly.

Chianti 'Castiglioni', 2004

Marchesi de Frescobaldi, Toscana

A lovely purple in appearance, luminous and clear. The nose shows a striking expressivity, with appealing, prominent fruit, in particular dark cherry, subtly softened by a touch of spice. Succulent pulp and a light touch of tannin enliven the palate, complemented by a judicious balance of alcohol and crisp acidity; the finish is impressive and luscious.

Merlot del Lazio 'Kron', 2003

Fontana Candida, Lazio

An intense red ruby coloured wine with aromas of red berries and mild spices finishing with a hint of tobacco. The small percentage of Sangiovese adds some extra complexity to the wine.

Montepulciano D'Abruzzo 'Iorio'

Umani Ronchi, Abruzzo

This wine is brilliant ruby-red in colour. Aromas of cherry and plum are complemented by cedar and spice on the nose. On the palate, the wine is well structured with fine tannins and a clean, persistent finish.

Santa Cristina 2003

Antinori, Toscana

This wine is made from 90% Sangiovese and 10% Merlot. Ruby red colour with purple hues. Vibrant ripe fruit on the nose with nice floral hints. Well structured, soft and harmonious. Sweet tannins and lingering fruit in the finish

Primitivo di Pulia 2004

Castello Monaci, Puglia

Dark red colour, on the nose has a smell of mature grapes, pepper and vanilla. The taste is robust full bodied but well balanced as well one can get hints of black forest fruit and liquorice with long lasting finish.

Grotta Rossa, Carignano del Sulcis 2004

Cantina Santadi, Sardegna

The wine is ruby red colour, on the nose it has an intense fruity scent with a final note of liquorice. Palate is elegant, with good body in the mouth.

Corvo Sciaranera , Nero D'Avola Frappato

Vini Corvo, Sicilia

Intense ruby colour with a tinge of violet, intense and fruity on the nose. Full bodied and fruity on the palate

Cusumano Benuara Nero D'Avola Syrah 2006

Sicilia

This well-known international grape thrives in the Sicilian climate. The resulting wine is a concentrated warm red with soft red fruit, extremely smooth tannin, and lingering herbal elements.

Sedara

Donnafugata, Sicilia

100% Nero D'Avola The ruby-red colour is rounded out by lively garnet reflections. The impact on the nose is intense with sensations of tobacco, spices and mineral notes. In the mouth, the wine is balanced with fruity flavours, mainly blackberries and cherries. Persistent finish.

Vino Rosso Di Malta – Maltese Red Wine

La Valette Vin Rouge

A full-bodied red wine with a mature, complex bouquet. This wine is predominantly produced from Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The strong character of this wine and its fruity aromas and flavours make it very versatile and enjoyable.

Medina Vineyards (Syrah, Grenache, Carigan) 2004

Delicata

The noble Syrah grape perform fabtastically under the hot Maltese sun and produces red wines of great charm and finesse.

Bel, (Syrah) 2004

Meridiana Winery

Made exclusively from Syrah grapes, Bel is characterised by silky, prune and peppery spice flavours which are enhanced by careful maturation in barrique. The name Bel recalls the Phoenician god of fertility worshipped under various names throughout the Punic world.
